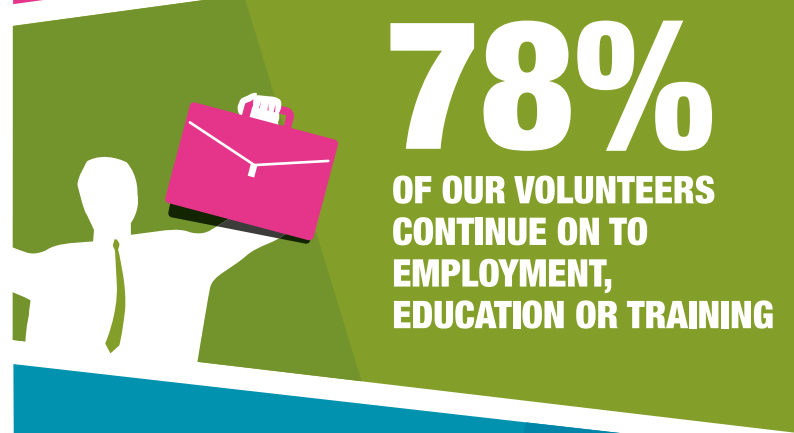
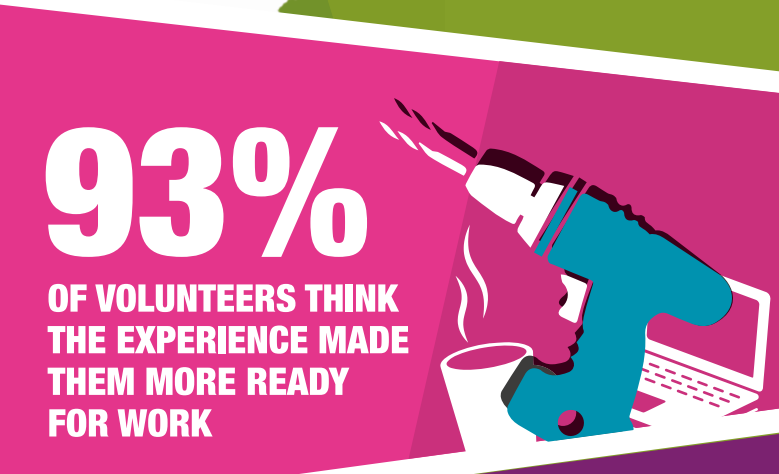

# OUR VOLUNTEERS MAKE A REAL DIFFERENCE

By taking on a ProjectScotland volunteer your organisation will benefit from their energy and talent, while helping a young person gain the skills, experience, and confidence they need to get on in life.

We support all kinds of volunteers - young people keen to break out of unemployment, graduates looking for experience, students fresh out of school, the list goes on! We work with organisations across Scotland, from large national organisations to small charities and not-for-profits.

## HOW IT WORKS

We work in partnership with you to create valuable volunteering opportunities for people aged 16-30 in Scotland. Each opportunity is designed to be 20-30 hours a week for a period of 3 months.

Young people make a positive choice to become a ProjectScotland volunteer. We spend time getting to know each volunteer, so that we can find the right match for them and for you.

## HOW WE HELP

Every partner is linked to a member of our partnerships team, who is on hand to provide advice and guidance. They will bring experience and knowledge, as well as local insights and support, enabling you to get the most out of partnering with ProjectScotland. They will check in regularly with you and the volunteer to ensure everyone is getting the most out of the placement.

ProjectScotland provides each volunteer with a mentor who supports them through their placement and encourages them to think about their next steps. We also provide regular employability workshops to help volunteers supercharge their CV and polish their interview skills.

Since 2005 our charity has supported over 5000 young people who have given over 3 million volunteering hours to charities and not-for-profits nationwide. Join our programme today.
